Maintain required enrollment

Direct Federal Loans require at least half-time enrollment for disbursement (6 credit hours per semester for undergraduates). Some grant programs require full-time enrollment (12 credit hours for undergraduates). Other grants disburse based on how many hours a student is enrolled. A loan/grant will be cancelled or reduced based on not meeting enrollment requirements by the last day to add or drop a course. Add/drop dates can be found at <u>registrar.wvu.edu</u>.
