

GRADUATE FINANCIAL AID CHECKLIST

The Financial Aid Process:

- Submit your Free Application for Student Aid (FAFSA) at studentaid.gov
- Log in to portal.wvu.edu to view any unsatisfied requirements
- After you receive your aid offer, log in to portal.wvu.edu to review and accept or decline your aid by clicking on the Financial Aid Information button. Find out how to accept or decline your aid at financialaid.wvu.edu.
- If you accept a Direct Subsidized and/or Unsubsidized Loan for the first time, you must complete BOTH requirements below at studentaid.gov
 - Entrance Counseling
 - Loan Agreement (MPN for a Subsidized/Unsubsidized Loan)
- Maintain required enrollment

Direct Federal Loans require at least half-time enrollment for disbursement. Some grant programs require full-time enrollment. Federal loans will be cancelled or reduced based on not meeting enrollment requirements by the last day to add or drop a course. Add/drop dates can be found at registrar.wvu.edu.

Other Available Funding Options:

- Apply for a Graduate PLUS Loan by completing the following requirements after logging into studentaid.gov with your FSA ID
 - Complete the Graduate PLUS Application process
 - If approved and a first time Graduate PLUS Loan borrower, you must complete Entrance Counseling and the Loan Agreement (PLUS MPN for Graduate/Professional students)
- Pursue a credit-based private loan to help fund your educational expenses

Sign up for the payment plan to make monthly payments toward your bill

Sign up for direct deposit if you are receiving a refund because your financial aid and payments are more than your institutional charges

Sign up at studentaccounts.wvu.edu/refunds. Otherwise, you will receive a paper check to the local mailing address listed on your account.

Research graduate tuition waiver options with the [Office of Graduate Education and Life](#)

If you are receiving a tuition waiver that is not reflected on your account, check with the department providing the waiver to ensure it has been submitted. The Office of Graduate Education and Life normally provides email updates throughout the process.

Need someone to contact us on your behalf?
